- Set your thermostat between 65 and 70 degrees. When you go to sleep or leave home, dial it down.
- Install a programmable thermostat to adjust the temperature automatically.
- Close heating vents and doors in unused rooms.
- Caulk around and install plastic sheeting over drafty windows.
- Install weather stripping around door frames.
- Use caulk or foam to seal gaps where pipes penetrate exterior walls.
- Install foam insulators under electrical outlet covers.

Over the long-term, consider having a home energy audit to determine a larger energy efficiency strategy, which could involve measures such as installing more insulation, upgrading to a high-efficiency furnace and replacing windows and doors.

EITC Offers Tax Relief for Low- and Moderate-Income Households

Peoples Gas has partnered with the City of Chicago and Mayor Richard M. Daley to urge customers to take full advantage of available tax relief when they file their tax returns this year.

Thousands of Chicagoans eligible for the federal Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) are not receiving it, either because they haven't heard about it or don't know how to apply. Eligible taxpayers can receive up to \$4,824 back. Last year, the average refund for Chicago residents who received the EITC was \$2,096.

Chicago taxpayers should call the city's information line at **311** to find out where to apply for the EITC.

Get Rebates for Energy-Efficient Improvements

This winter's frigid temperatures may inspire some homeowners to make long-term improvements to boost energy efficiency, and a new program provides rebates for many types of upgrades.

From now through April, Peoples Gas customers can save up to \$750 on insulation, \$600 on boilers, \$450 on furnaces, \$400 on water heaters and \$100 on clothes washers through the **Chicagoland Natural Gas Savings Program**.
